Our skilled artisans then transform these woods into one-of-a-kind works of art. Five of the most common woods we use are *Brauna, Canela Preta, Peroba, Cedro and Canela Parda*. BB supports the preservation of Brazil's endangered rainforests by using only antique hardwoods and is currently beginning to use exotic woods from sustainable forests. The reclaimed wood we use provides the benefit of old growth timber without cost to the environment.

To achieve our signature distressed and multi layered paint look, our artisans employ techniques much the same as those used by16th century European fresco masters. These time honored techniques have been passed down through families for generations and are still used by our artisans today. Seven layers of polychromatic paint are meticulously applied and the furniture goes through a series of distressing processes which include spoke shaving, sanding and gouging. Wormholes in the wood naturally enhance the look we strive for. Nail holes, bolt holes and other fastener marks also add to the characteristic appeal of each piece.

Our hand forged hardware is shaped by talented metalsmiths. Any of our hardware pieces can be customized to your clients' needs.
